

## Scholarships

### **1. AMERICAN SOCIETY OF CLINICAL PATHOLOGY SCHOLARSHIPS - \$1,000**

Must be in final clinical year of accredited program in medical technology or related discipline, have a minimum 3.0 GPA (out of 4.0), be US citizen or permanent resident. Selection criteria include academic achievement, financial need, leadership activities and potential for success in the profession.

### **3. HEALTH EDUCATION LOAN FUND (DR. ROBERT D. ROWLEY)**

Student must already be accepted into the health field as a full time student. Up to \$1,500 may be borrowed. Four-percent interest begins at graduation, with repayment to be made within 3 years.

### **4. GREAT RIVER MEDICAL CENTER LOAN/SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

Primarily intended to support students currently enrolled or accepted into an accredited post-secondary healthcare education program through the basic entry-level requirements for a position. Monies awarded are primarily a student loan plan, repayable in time, money, or both. The number and size of loans/scholarships varies. In the event that Great River Medical Center does not have full time position available, the loan becomes a scholarship.

### **5. Veterans affairs Medical Center (VAMC) tuition Grant**

Based on financial need, scholarship, enrollment as a pre-clinical laboratory sciences major, and a commitment to employment at VAMC before and after graduation. Length of commitment to employment after graduation is based upon the number of semesters tuition grant is received. Restricted to tuition only. Renewable for 1 year.
